We are pleased to announce that the Astronomical Society of the Palm Beaches is presenting an annual “Award for Outstanding Scholarship and Merit in Astronomy.” The award this year will be at least \$1000. It is our intention that it be presented to a junior or senior high school student who has demonstrated academic excellence, especially in the sciences, as well as an outstanding and active interest in astronomy. *We ask your help in getting this application into the hands of potential applicants in your school.*

As part of this package, an application form is enclosed. After completing the required student portion of the application, the applicant should submit the form to the science department chairperson or another faculty member, familiar with the applicant, who will complete the "Applicant Appraisal" portion of the application.

Deadline for submission of the application is February 1, 2010. Application submission must be via U.S. mail to the ASPB post office box. Candidates will be evaluated by a committee composed of ASPB members. A winner will be selected by April 15th, 2010. Shortly thereafter, the administration of the sponsoring school will be contacted and a check for the amount of the scholarship will be issued to the student recipient.
